The ASI6585 merges Axia's Livewire with advanced audio processing on one adapter. Using a powerful Texas Instruments onboard floating point DSP with Axia Livewire networked audio allows the ASI6585 to simultaneously play up to eight streams of audio that can be mixed to eight stereo outputs, and record up to eight audio streams fed from eight stereo inputs, over switched Ethernet. The ASI6585 also has MRX multi-rate mixing, MPEG Layer 2 and 3 encoding and decoding, and TSX time scaling. Two streams are available for SSX multichannel record and playback.
